### Low flow toilet rebate program

Residential customers can receive a \$50.00 credit on their water bill for the installation of a 6 litre flush toilet. Offer is limited to one rebate per customer.

### Showerhead swap

Bring your old shower-head into ACAP Cape Breton and receive a new low flow model free of charge. A water-saving showerhead can reduce faucet use by up to 50%.

## Example Residential Bill - 2013

### quarterly / every three months

Base Charge:	51.52
Consumption Rate:	1.23
average consumption:	60 m3
Consumption Charge	73.80
Total	\$125.32

Note: this example is for an average residential water bill. Customers who conserve or consume water at a rate lower than the average will have a lower quarterly bill.
