Bylaw G1

PENALTIES

1. Unless otherwise specifically provided in a Bylaw or in the statute that authorized the making of a Bylaw, any person violating any of the provisions of any of the Bylaws of the Cape Breton Regional Municipality is liable on conviction to a penalty of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) exclusive of costs, and in default of payment thereof to imprisonment for a term of not less than five days (5) nor more than ninety (90) days.

PASSED AND ADOPTED by a majority of the whole Council at a duly called meeting of the Cape Breton Regional Municipal Council held on the 17th day of October 1995.
